How to create an account at NREMT


- Step 1: Open your web browser and type www.nremt.org







How to apply to take your NREMT Cognitive Examination

- Step 5 continued: Please pay special attention to the name verification. This name must match your government issued ID (i.e. Driver's License) in order to be admitted to the NREMT test site


The name you entered must match the first and last names exactly with the two forms of identification (The first ID must be a non-expired government-issued ID that includes a permanently affixed photo and your signature. The second ID must be non-expired and include your name and signature. Acceptable photo identification is limited to the following: State Issued Driver's License; State issued Identification Card; Military Identification Card; Passport) that must be presented to the Pearson Vue Test Proctor on the day of testing.

Disclaimer: It is important to remember; you will not be permitted to test and you will forfeit your testing fee if you are unable to present the required IDs to the test proctor at the scheduled examination center. 

- The application process for NREMT testing involves multiple parts:
 - NREMT will track your application steps and issue your National Registry Authorization to Test (ATT) letter – when applicable
 - Your teaching agency will verify your successful course completion. ***Under 18 y/o by MIEMSS***
 - MIEMSS will verify your successful practical (psychomotor) exam completion

Additional information

- **Payment** – If you are affiliated with a Maryland EMS program your testing fee for the practical (psychomotor) and first cognitive attempt are covered.
- If not affiliated, you will need to pay:
 - MIEMSS \$60 for the EMT practical
 - NREMT for the cognitive
 - EMR \$65
 - EMT \$70
