In order to help you prepare for the National Registry Examination, MFRI is pleased to offer access to unlimited online computer adaptive practice tests, also known as Platinum Education. In order to access these tests, please follow the instructions provided below.

Create Your Account (if you have not done so previously)

1. Visit www.emstesting.com
2. Click the red **“Students Sign up Here”** button on the left side of the screen.
3. Complete the registration form, and follow the instructions to verify your email address.
